- Able to count music and count themselves in across the floor.

Junior Company + Senior Performance Troupe

- Clean Double en dehor pirouette on both sides. Jazz and ballet.
- 2 of 3 splits all the way down.
- Chassé, run, run, grand jeté/ leap with a full split on both side.
- Side leap both sides.
- Fouetté jump
- Sissone jump
- Calypso jump.
- Piqué turns + 1 double piqué
- Chainé turns
- Piqué arabesque
- Fan kick- open at the top
- Illusion
- Leg hold
- Able to count music and count themselves in across the floor.
- Tombé pas de bourre pirouette exercise across the floor.
- Understanding of fouetté turns and turns in 2<sup>nd</sup>.

- Piqué, piqué, double piqué, step over turn, double step over turn.
- Chainé turns into relevé arabesque.
- Piqué arabesque
- Fan kick- layout
- Illusion
- Leg hold/ leg hold turn
- Able to count music and count themselves in across the floor.
- Tombé pas de bourre pirouette exercise across the floor.
- Double pirouette, 8 fouettés into a double pirouette (turned out) Tricks (optional):

Age 9 + 1-2 years competitive experience within a group. 2 Full splits 1 Full split leap Ages 9-10 years old: clean single pirouette on both sides Ages 10-13: clean double pirouette one side- single on the other. 14+ clean triple pirouette on one side- double on the other. Comfortable with facial expressions and story telling on stage.

Solos require a large commitment including time and financially. A minimum competition entry is approx. \$145/solo per competition and solo choreography fees start at \$300. Please keep that in mind as you start to explore your options.

If you are a Junior or Senior in HS and are interested in exploring an outside solo choreographer, please let us know on your audition paperwork. All outside choreographers need to be approved by Miss Danielle and each dancer will hire them independently of PMDS.
